* If students at LaGuardia opt to take ENG 289 (= QC ENGL 170W), 290 (= QC 251), and 292 (= QC 253), then their remaining courses for the major at Queens will be ENGL 241 (4 crs), 242 (4 crs), 243 (4 crs), 244 (4 crs), 391W (3 crs), and an open elective (3 crs). If they do not take ENG 289 at LaGuardia, they will need to take ENGL 170W at Queens. If they do not take ENG 290 at LaGuardia, they will have to select an elective in pre-1800 British literature. If they do not take ENG 292 at LaGuardia, they will have to select an elective in pre-1900 American literature.

** The major at Queens is 46 credits, but 3 credits (for ENGL 130, CW2) have been counted in the required general education credits above.

Procedures for reviewing, updating, modifying or terminating agreement:






