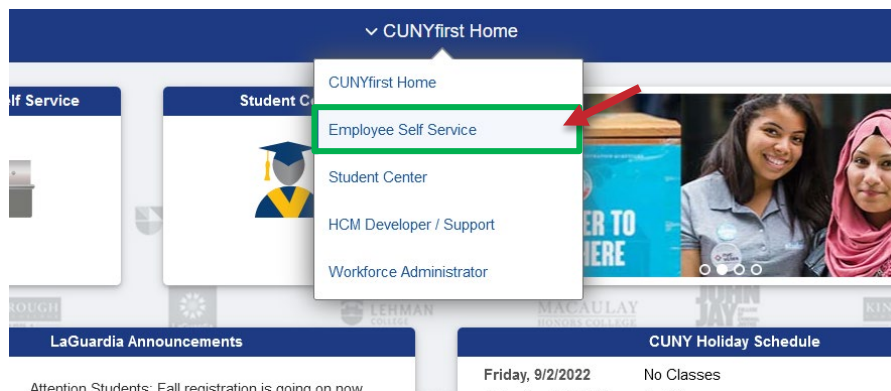

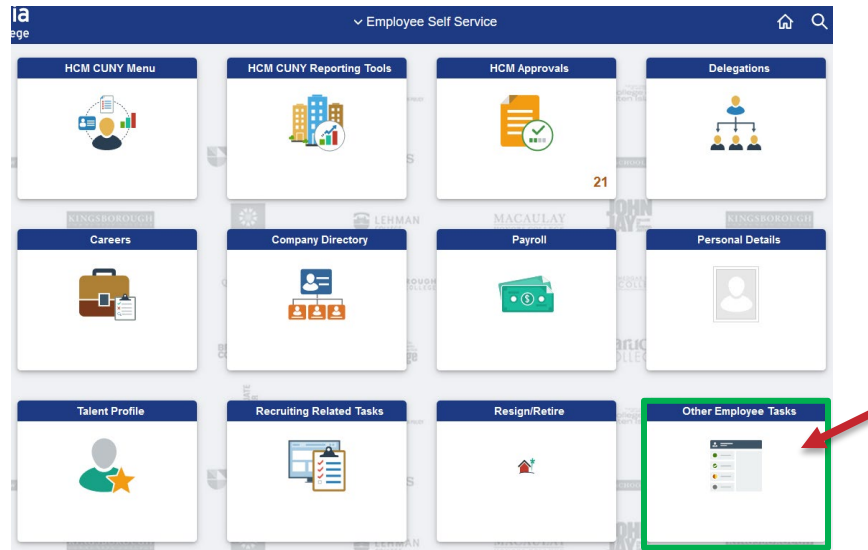

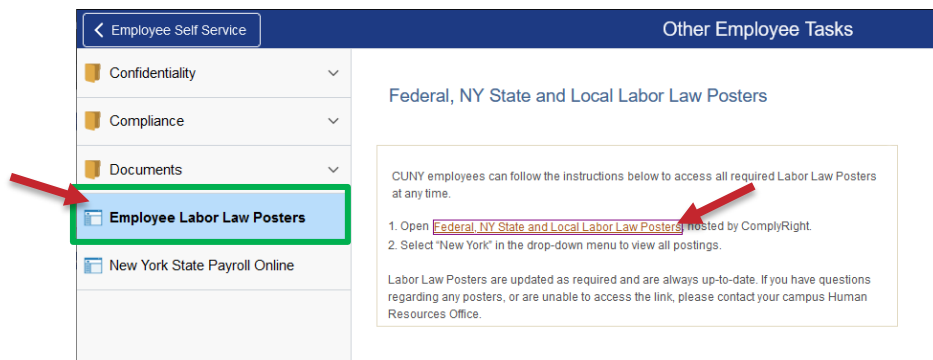
2. Navigate to 'Employee Self-Service'



3. Click on 'Other Employee Tasks'

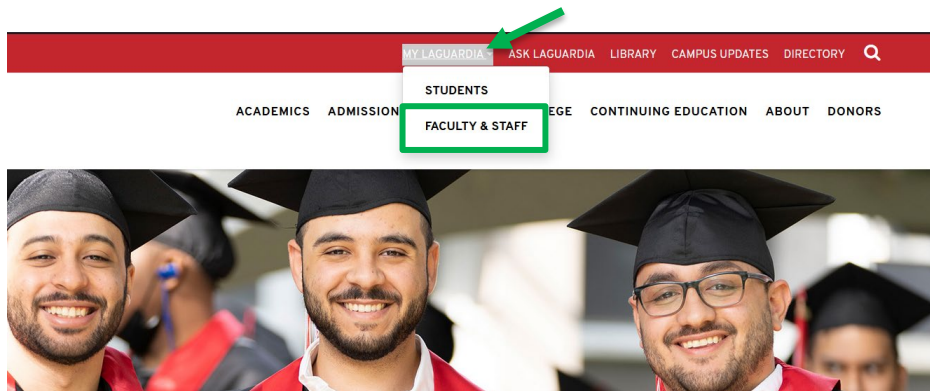


4. Click on 'Employee Labor Law Posters'. The page will display the link for the 'Federal NY State and Local Labor Law Posters'. This will provide the information.
